FTA Announces Maduros Next Board President Board first vice president to succeed retiring President Barca

The Federation of Tax Administrators (FTA) announced today that California Department of Tax and Fee Administration (CDTFA) Director Nick Maduros will assume the role of FTA Board of Trustees President on April 9, 2024.

Director Maduros currently serves as the FTA Board's first vice president and, pursuant to FTA association's bylaws, will replace President Peter Barca who announced his retirement effective April 9.

Barca, who has served on the FTA Board since 2019 and as its president since last June, is retiring after leading the Wisconsin Department of Revenue for more than five years as secretary and after many decades of devoted public service to the state of Wisconsin as a U.S. Congressman and state legislator.

"We are grateful for Secretary Barca's dedicated leadership and commitment to tax administration, and we wish him well in his future endeavors," said FTA Executive Director Sharonne Bonardi. "We are fortunate to have the gavel now passed into the very capable hands of Director Maduros as we continue to do the important work of delivering excellence in tax administration."

Maduros was first appointed CDTFA director by California Governor Jerry Brown and reappointed by current Governor Gavin Newsom. Director Maduros leads a team of more than 4,000 CDTFA staff members, administering 42 tax and fee programs that generate more than \$96 billion annually for the state of California, its cities, and counties.

Prior to his CDTFA appointment, Maduros served in the Obama Administration as chief of staff of the U.S. Small Business Administration.

Earlier in his career, Maduros worked as an attorney and founded two successful public affairs firms in Washington, DC. He advised leading nonprofit organizations and corporations on a broad range of high-profile public policy challenges.

Maduros is a graduate of Yale College and Harvard Law School. A native of Stockton, California, he now lives in Davis with his wife and three young daughters.
