Economic Impact of the World Trade Center Attack

- Over 34 million square feet of office space was destroyed or damaged.
- About 138,000 jobs were displaced.
- GCP for 2001 declined by \$14b -- from \$443b to \$429b.
- Lost tax revenue: FY02 \$1.6b, FY03 \$1.4b

Revenue Estimation

- Need for immediate answers on revenue impact (impossible)
- New legislation to be evaluated

Administrative Issues

- Delayed payments
- Assessment process
