

Consumer indicators show improvement Rate




Consumer indicators show

improvement Real Disposable Income Per Capita




There are significant variations across the states

Unemployment Rates




So what will happen with retail?

Overall consumer spending should accelerate in 2016




For the upcoming holiday season, we are forecasting retail sales to Increase 3.5 to 4.0 Percent
